

Govt to recruit over 164,000 Kenyans for national census

The government will recruit over 164,000 Kenyans to oversee this year's national population and housing census to be done this August. Advertisements seeking to invite eligible Kenyans to apply for the jobs are expected to be published in all media outlets by the end of next week. Ms. Waweru said unlike 2009 population census which was paper based, this year's exercise will see the deployment of mobile based technology in data collection in a bid to ensure that the final figures are accurate.
